WHAT MAKES A GOOD CV?

- Professional email address
- CV outlining your skills and abilities your achievements to date
- Demonstrate experience: School plays/Drama club, Choir, Duke of Edinburgh, Organising school events/activities, Talent Show, Charity Fundraising, Sports Day
- Good communication interview practice/role plays
- Able to demonstrate a good work attitude

- No more than 2 sides of A4 Paper
