b. women's right to vote - Wearing scarves in the colours of the suffragette movement (green, white and violet), women marched through London, Edinburgh, Cardiff and Belfast. The 1918 Representation of the People Act, granted propertyowning British women over age 30 the right to vote. It would be another decade before women in the UK would have the same voting rights as men.
