

a. yoghurt - The researchers said many yoghurts are full of sugar and the public should not be lulled into thinking they are eating healthy products. Only natural and Greek-style yoghurts could be classed as low in sugar, the report said. Yoghurt desserts contained the most sugar - an average of 16.4g per 100g. Yoghurt manufacturers have been reducing the sugar content in recent years, but there is still a long way to go to meet expectations in the Government's sugar-reduction programme.



c. Emmy - It's an American award that recognizes excellence in the television industry, and is the equivalent of an Academy Award for film.












b. 1969 - Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin walked on the moon during the Apollo 11 mission. A third astronaut, Michael Collins, piloted the command spacecraft alone in lunar orbit until Armstrong and Aldrin returned to it just under a day later for the trip back to Earth. The mission from earth took 8 days in total.




What is the last name of this UK sportsman?
