

True or false, North Korea has agreed to halt missile testing until after the Winter Olympics which is being held in South Korea?


False - North Korea launched another missile test last week. In response to the launch, South Korea's military conducted its own missile drills that started just minutes after North Korea's launch was detected.





c. a volcano has erupted - Bali's Mt Agung has finally erupted, two months after tens of thousands of local residents were evacuated from their homes around the volcano.








This amazing stunt was performed high above the Swiss Alps last week. What is the name of the suit the stuntman is wearing?






What is the name of the virtual currency used online that has rapidly increased in value? a. Webcoin b. eCoin c. Bitcoin






What prevented this van from toppling over rail until Yorkshire fire services arrived? a. a handbag strap b. a policeman c. a single wheel
