High Quality Provision and Facilities

Our newly extended and renovated Sixth Form block boasts excellent facilities.

Our excellent outcomes are achieved through high quality teaching and the excellent relationships forged between staff and students.

There is an emphasis, particularly in the early stages of Year 12, on students being supported to develop the skills necessary to become effective independent learners. Students have access to a wide range of excellent facilities to support their learning. The newly extended Sixth Form block houses a number of dedicated Sixth Form classrooms, two ICT workrooms where students can work in a quiet area throughout the day, and a large Sixth Form common room with a cafe, where students can relax.

Students also have access to sports facilities, including our new fully-equipped fitness suite.





Developing Mind and Character ...Building your Future

CHSG Sixth Form students are SUCCESSFUL students.

We are very proud of our tradition of high achievement in the Sixth Form. Our A Level pass rate is consistently above the national average and annually a very high proportion of entries achieve the highest grades. Results for vocational courses are also exceptional and significantly above the National average. (Full details of the results are shown as part of the inserts).

The majority of students progress to university, including a high number to Russell Group universities. Others choose more vocational pathways or career opportunities with further training. Whatever their choice, students are fully supported with applications and preparation for interview.

Personal Development

The Personal Development (PD) programme has been designed to focus on other aspects outside of the classroom; to develop self-confidence and leadership as well as skills and knowledge to prepare for life beyond the Sixth Form.

As part of the programme, students focus on a number of key areas. Some of the units are compulsory but others optional, allowing students to have ownership of what they study and ensuring the topics covered are relevant to their needs and future plans. Students begin their UCAS preparation in Year 12 to ensure they are ready to submit their application at the beginning of Year 13.

We find that as a result students are confident about applications and it also ensures they get the best university places.

In the summer of Year 12 students undertake work experience. They are encouraged to find their own placement with the aim that it will be relevant to their future career. Students are also involved in a one day conference that allows them to explore important and topical political or social issues. Past conferences have included 'the true nature of beauty' and human trafficking.

Academic Support and Guidance

We have a rigorous' Maximising Achievement' programme. This means students are focused on achieving their goals but are also clear about what they need to do to get there.

Specialist Teachers

Teaching staff are highly qualified specialists who are experts in their respective academic areas. They treat students as individuals and give them all the support they need to reach their full potential. Many of our staff have been examiners and this helps them ensure their



meet their needs and prepare them fully for the next stage.

Pastoral Support and Guidance

Strong pastoral care, support and guidance are extremely important in contributing towards our students' success. The Sixth Form Leadership Team, together with the pastoral team, play an integral role in supporting students through their time at CHSG.

Our Higher Education scheme provides excellent quidance so students have a step-by-step approach to researching options and making successful UCAS applications.

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Support

Strong pastoral care, support and guidance are extremely important in contributing towards our students' success.

The Sixth Form Leadership Team, along with the tutor team, play an integral role in supporting students. We have a clear framework for learning and students are tracked and monitored using a variety of data and information. As an experienced team, students benefit from our care and guidance and where appropriate, a range of links with outside agencies.

We aim to keep tutor groups small and to keep tutors with the same students throughout the Sixth Form. Tutors undertake a number of roles in offering advice and guidance to help students make the transition into the Sixth Form quickly and enjoy their Sixth Form experience. Tutors also undertake academic mentoring which includes regular one to one reviews of progress to support students to meet their targets.

Tutors also help deliver the Personal Development Programme and support students to make applications for higher education or employment.

Additional Support for Year 13 students:

Year 13 students are assigned a mentor group or an individual mentor. The mentor and group will focus on helping students prepare for their exams. The programme aims to develop student confidence and exam skills to ensure success.

Our extensive UCAS preparation for university, including specialist programmes for those wishing to apply to Oxford or Cambridge or medicine, is a key feature of our provision.

Enrichment

Enrichment as part of Sixth Form life displays our commitment to developing and broadening students' skills and enjoyment of Sixth Form life. We offer a varied programme of additional activities. Some of these activities can lead to a qualification or Sixth Form certificate.
