

15 October (18:00 UK time) for all courses at the universities of Oxford and Cambridge, and most courses in medicine, veterinary science, veterinary medicine, and dentistry.

15 January (18:00 UK time) for the majority of courses.

24 March (18:00 UK time) for some art and design courses.

UCAS terms explained

Clearing – Available from July to September. If you don't have a place, you can check which unis still have spaces. Use the UCAS search tool to find a course. Adjustment – You are eligible if you have met and exceeded the conditions of your firm choice and have been accepted on that course. You can look for a different course while still holding your confirmed place.

Extra – You might be able to add another choice if you've received decisions from all five universities or colleges and weren't accepted, or if you declined the offers you received.
