Job to do:

Create your own story using treble clef notation.

1. Make a list of words you can make using the notes of the treble clef (A, B, C, D, E, F, G)

2. Start drafting your story. Look back at your list of words that you made last week and think about how you could incorporate these into your story. They might even help you form your story line.

• Success Criteria:

- ✓ You must use good English.
- ✓ Use capital letters and full stops.
- ✓ It must have an interesting and appropriate story.
- ✓ At least 15 words and no more than 30 words should be coded into treble clef notation.

Hints/Tips:

1. Look back at the treble clef stories we have done in class.
2. Make a list of words that you could use using the notes of the treble clef.
3. Think about how you might present your story. One way of doing it might be to create a storyboard. How else could you present your work?



5. FINAL CHECKS:

Before submitting your extended homework task have a member of the class look over your story and try to solve the coded words. Do they have any suggestions for improvement?

4. EVALUATE your story:

- Does it make sense?
- Could it be improved?
- If so, how? **TIP:** Look back at the success criteria. Does it fulfil the criteria?

3. Write up your story with your words coded into treble clef. How are you going to present it?
