BTEC qualifications - Myths

For students with more moderate GCSE grades

Not equivalent to A level

Easier than A level

For students with lower aspirations

For naughty students

Don't derive UCAS points

Won't enable you to progress to university



BTEC qualifications - Truths

Different sizes dependent on the number of Units Certificate, Award, Diploma, Extended Diploma

Combine academic theory units with practical units

Assessed through a combination of continuous assignment - tests, essays, research projects, practicals, field work, experiments and exams!

Prepare you for employment through work experience and vocationally focussed/applied units

Graded - Pass, Merit, Distinction, Distinction *

Earn UCAS points just like A Levels




