




True or false, Manchester City has won the Premier League title for the second year in a row






Several of these animals were spotted in the River Clyde at the weekend. What is the official one-word name for these creatures?


The Home Office has indicated it will help commonwealth citizens that migrated here decades ago, but have struggled to prove they are in the UK legally. What name has been given to this group?


Which UK city is shown in this photo and will host the 2022 Commonwealth Games?


