a. India - Justin Trudeau and his family have been on a diplomatic trip to India. Political commentators have said the trip was a 'political mess'





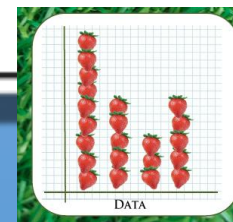
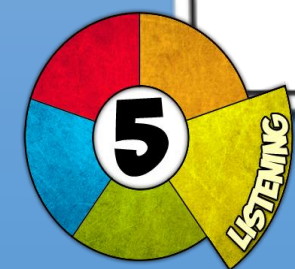

b. London - Queen Elizabeth made her first visit to London Fashion Week to present an award recognising British design excellence.



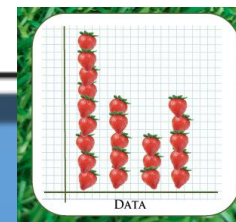
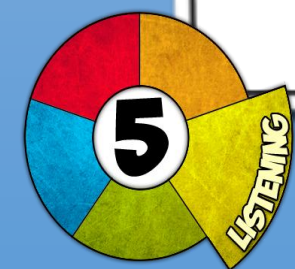
