




Thousands of people marched through the streets of Edinburgh at the weekend. What were they marching about?

a. Tube Web Spiders




Which billionaire has had to step down as chairman of Tesla following a court order?




What is the first name of this British television icon?

a. Lewis Hamilton (F1 Driver)


b. Anthony Joshua (Boxer)


Which European country has just held a vote about a possible name change?

What is the highest point of the United Kingdom? a. Snowdon






In which famous London location was this photo taken?

b. Trafalgar Square - The red lion is part of the 'Please Feed the Lions' art installation where visitors can have the lion generate poetry based on keywords that they supply.














Who is the leader of the Labour Party?

b. Jeremy Corbyn - As leader of the largest party outside government, Jeremy Corbyn is also Leader of the Opposition in parliament.














True or false, the executive producer of the James Bond movie franchise has confirmed that the next 007 will be a woman?

a. LA Lakers




In which country did natural disasters cause this damage?


Tolls are set to be be removed earlier than expected on two bridges crossing the Severn. Where would you likely be travelling if you are crossing the River Severn?

a. a large emerald worth £3 million


b. an ancient viking sword


What have organisers of the Bridgend Remembrance Sunday banned from this year's parade?



a. he made a Youtube video showing him driving while sitting backwards in his seat


b. he let a monkey drive the bus




What is the capital city of Australia? a. Sydney b. Melbourne c. Canberra


In which UK city did this event take place recently?
