




This man was awarded an OBE in the Queen's Birthday Honours. What is his first name?



a. The beaches of France - The D-Day operation took place on Tuesday, 6 June 1944. Amphibious landings along 50 miles of coast were preceded by extensive aerial and naval bombardment. 24,000 US, British, and Canadian airborne troops landed shortly after midnight. Although the landings led to a decisive victory, it is estimated the Allies suffered casualties of over 10,000 soldiers.










Which artist has just been named the world's hip-hop billionaire by the influential Forbe's Magazine? a. Beyoncé b. Jay-Z c. Kanye West
