



b. Tornado - Eight RAF Tornado jets returned home to the UK for the last time as the aircraft prepares for retirement after almost 40 years in service.




















True or false, the German Government placed speed limits on all of their famous autobahn motorway system?




Which major world landmark is shown at the centre of this photo?



a. junk food - Posters for food and drink high in fat, salt and sugar have been removed from the Underground, Overground, buses and bus shelters.
















Which type of plane has been grounded throughout the world after two devastating crashes?




Which artist created this image in southern Wales?
