a. Liverpool - The Reds erased the disappointment of last season's Champions League final loss by claiming the trophy for the sixth time with victory over Tottenham in Madrid.



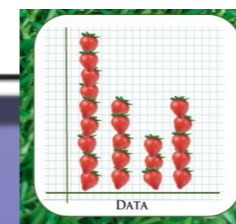
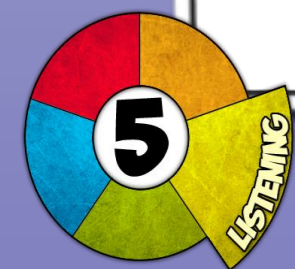

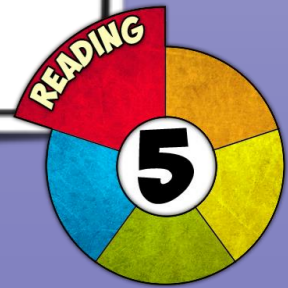
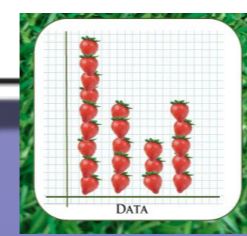
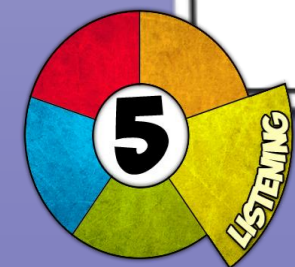




British band, The Verve, have finally been given the full ownership rights of their famous song 'Bittersweet Symphony'. Which iconic band has held ownership rights since 1997?

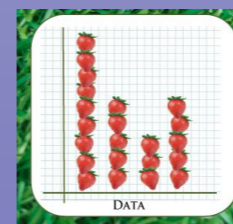
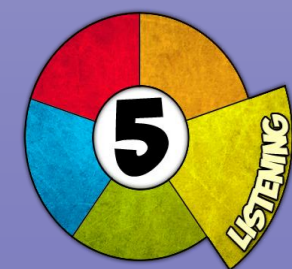
