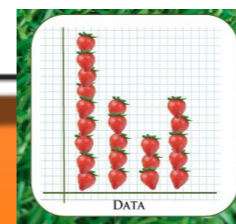
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Which political party is the third largest in the UK Parliament after the Conservatives and Labour?

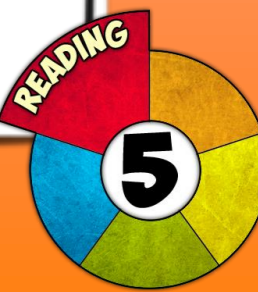
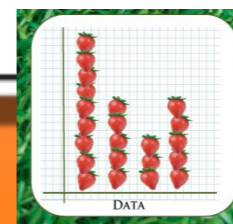




Why is a fiery debate breaking out across Beverly Hills, California?

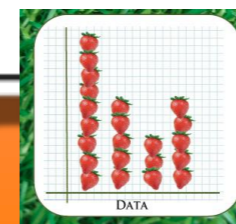




Why did the Guinness World Records refuse a record for the fastest marathon in a nurses uniform?

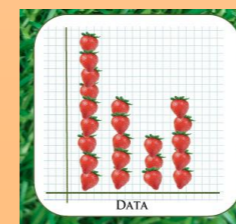
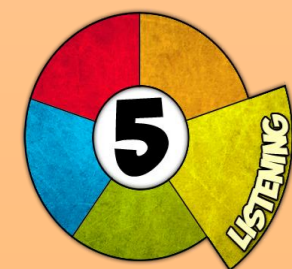

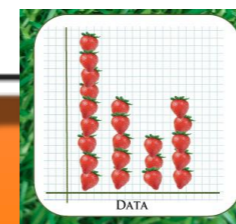




Which major UK city has recently introduced traffic-free days in their city centre?

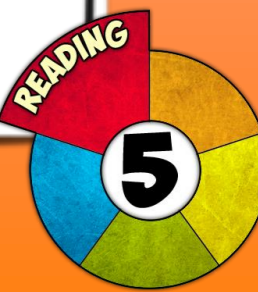
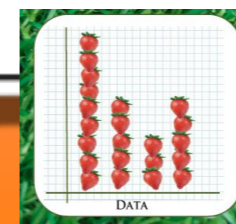

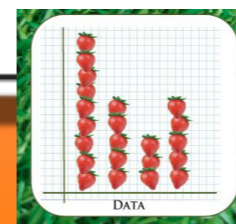
c. The Moon - It is one of the large dark patches on the moon, caused by iron-rich sediment from ancient volcanic eruptions.

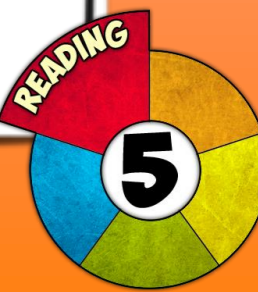
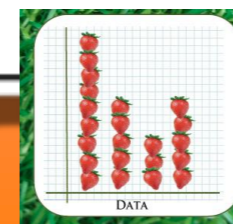




A UK player was finally defeated in what could be the longest ever single continuous game of Minecraft. How long had he been playing the same game?

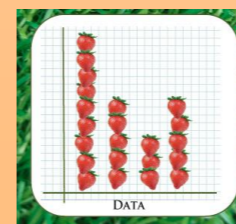
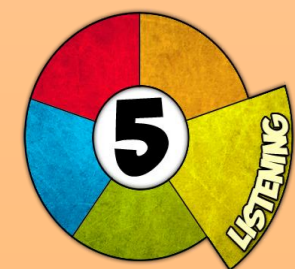
