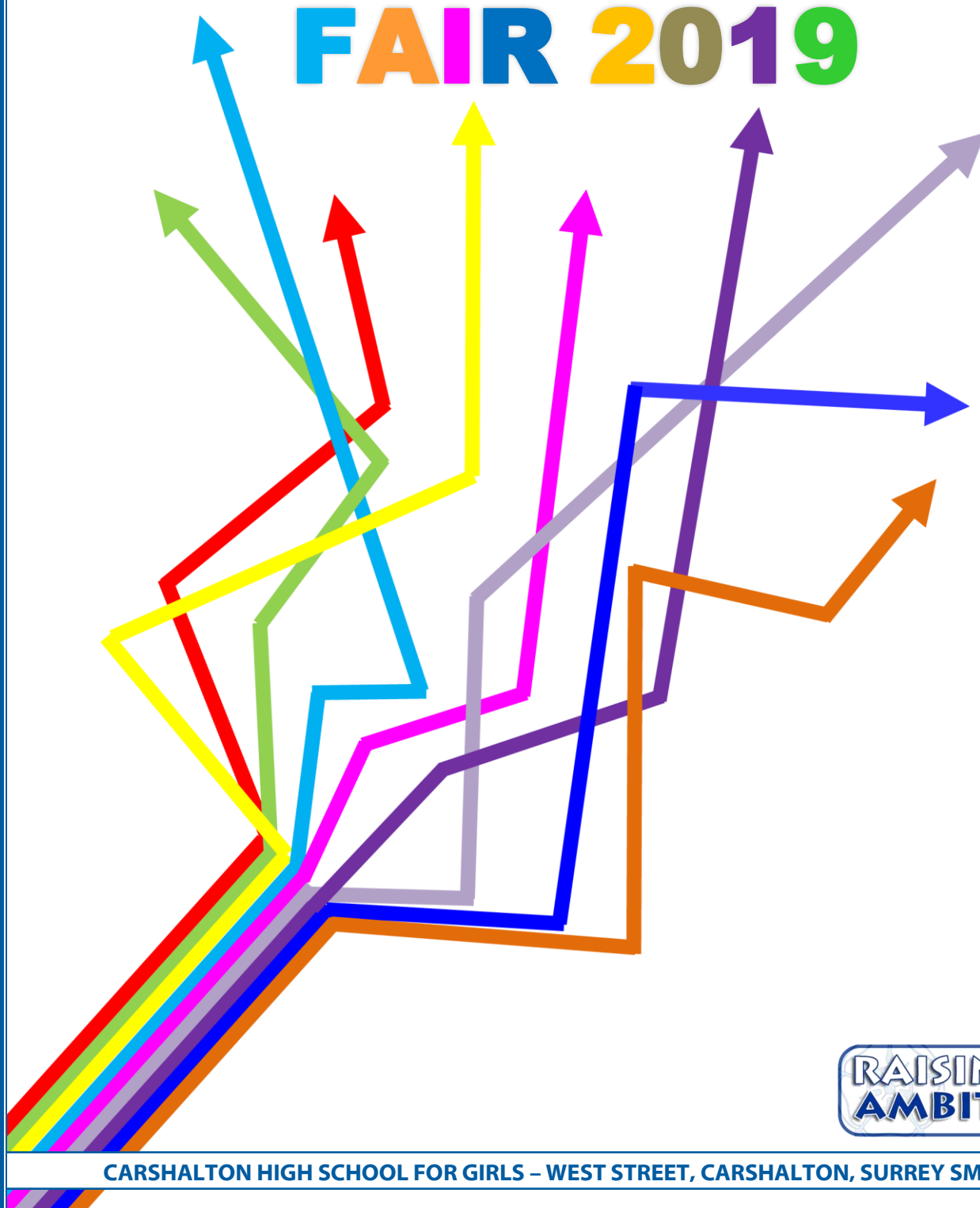

What are the entry requirements for your programmes? Ask about qualifications, age, previous experience, starting dates etc.?

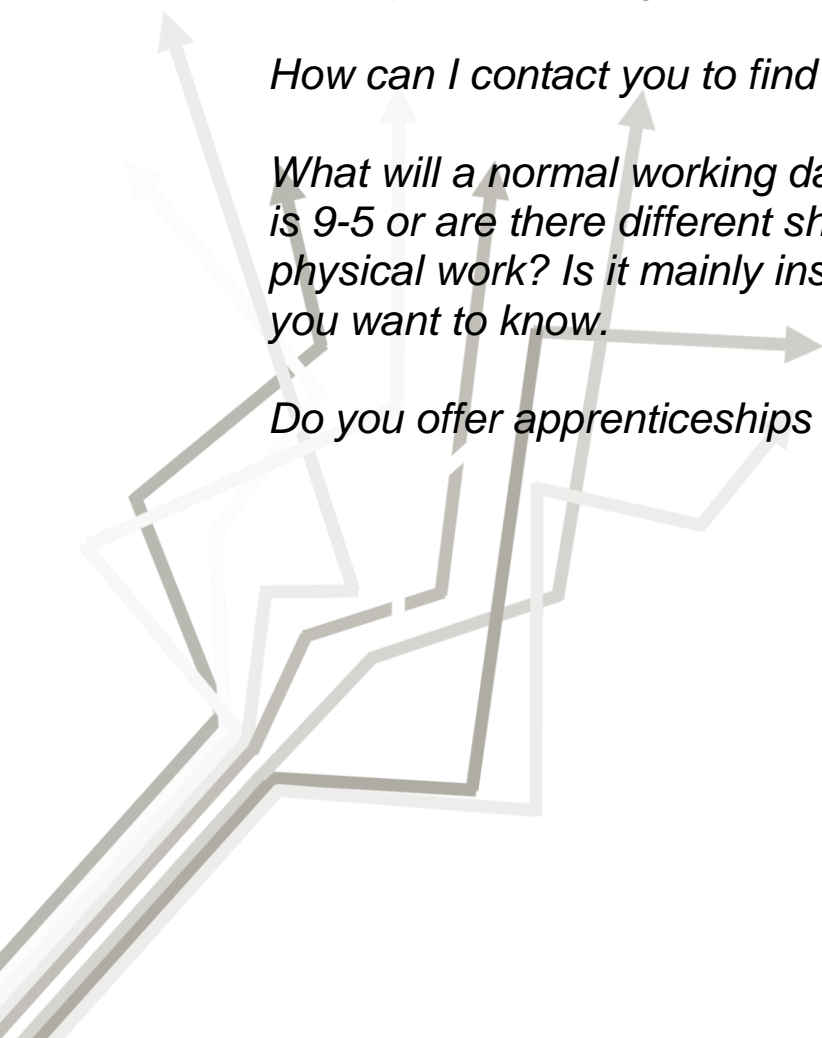
What opportunities are likely to be available to me once I've finished my training?
