




Rewards at Carshalton High School for Girls

At the end of each term, the students in each year group with the highest number of Golden Tickets receive an Amazon voucher.

Well done to all the students who attended the UCAS Exhibition at Excel and the Apprenticeship show at Sandown in March - you were a credit to your Year group.


The events helped crystallise or Sixth Formers ideas about where they might go and what they might achieve once they leave school.

We wish Sophie much success in her imminent races and for her future in her swimming challenges. #teamchsg



Knitting and Crochet Club

A big well done to the Knitting & Crochet Club!

The Knitting & Crochet Club have been creating premature baby blankets, lap blankets for the elderly, bonding squares and sensory preemie octopuses. It is great to see some pieces coming together and the progress of different techniques used. The Sixth Formers aim to send out gift packages to local hospitals and care homes in the borough.

Bonding squares are wonderful for mothers and babies who are separated due to emergency care within the neonatal unit. This means that they can share and experience the scent of each other when it might not be possible at times to see each other.

Along with these the octopuses will prevent premature new-borns from playing with wires and tubes that are attached; they can also help elderly residents with dementia when they feel distressed. The baby blankets and elderly lap blankets are used to provide comfort.

The past month Knitting & Crochet Club Sixth Formers have put in effort to plan and set goals for completing the project hopefully in June. Blankets and squares have been handmade and ready to put together. We continue to make more progress as we work each week.
