


Excellence doesn't come easily, but it is possible.


To be excellent will require you to do your very best each day, in every aspect of your school life.

Mr Conduit-Smith oversees behaviour and conduct in school (amongst other responsibilities!). What three things did he say were extremely important to ensure your learning is successful?












If you watched someone with an excellent attitude to learning in a lesson, what might you see them doing?








Fast-forward to the Christmas holidays. Which three words or phrases might you want your Form Tutor to use to describe the ways that you've been excellent in the Autumn term?
