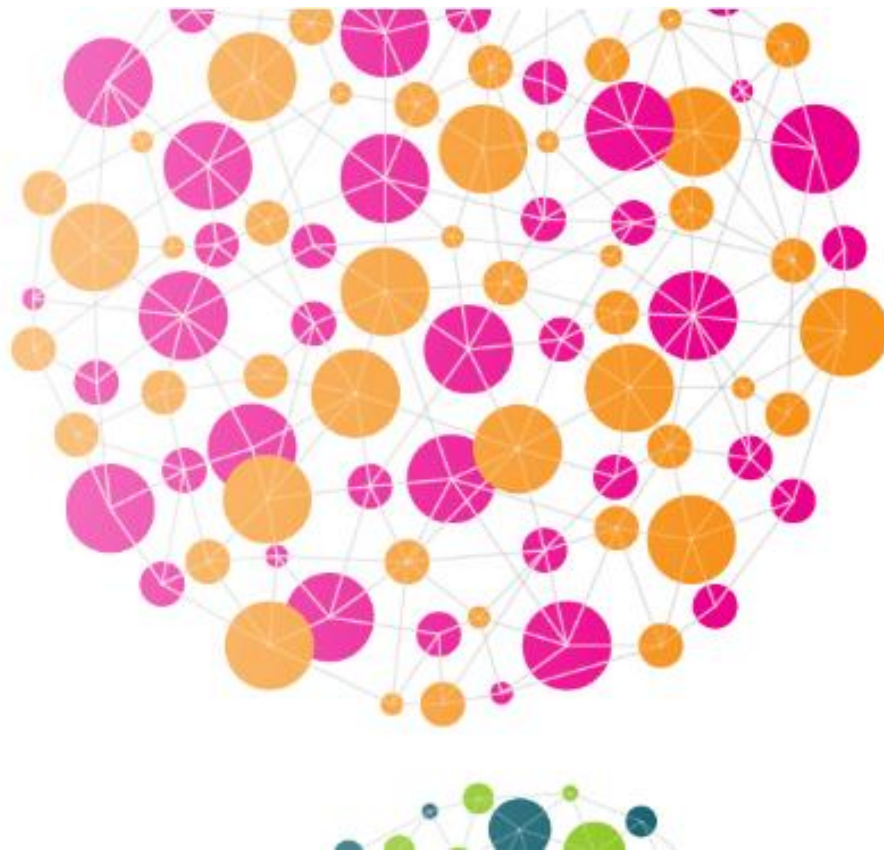

Who is this?

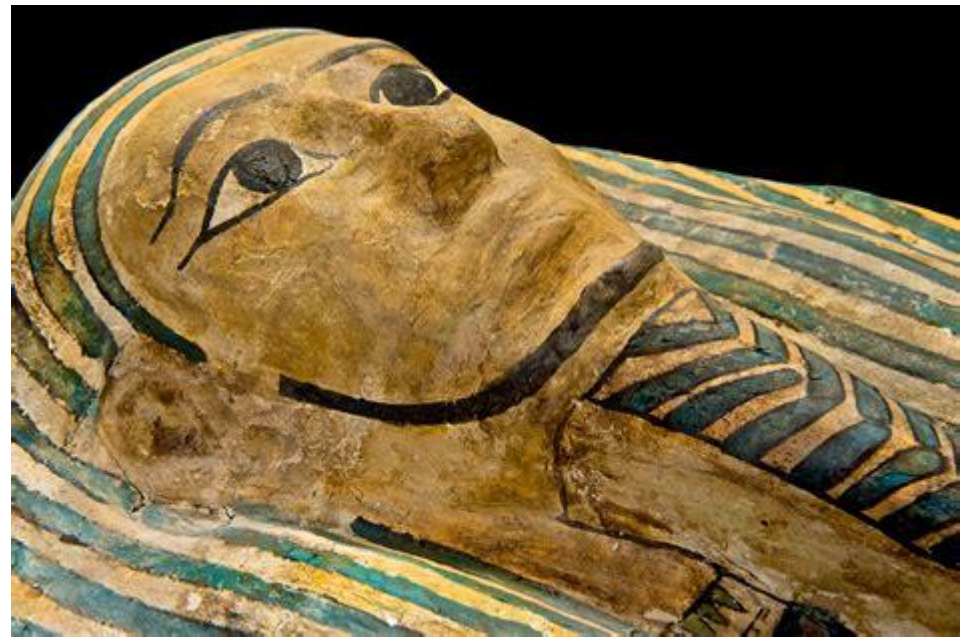

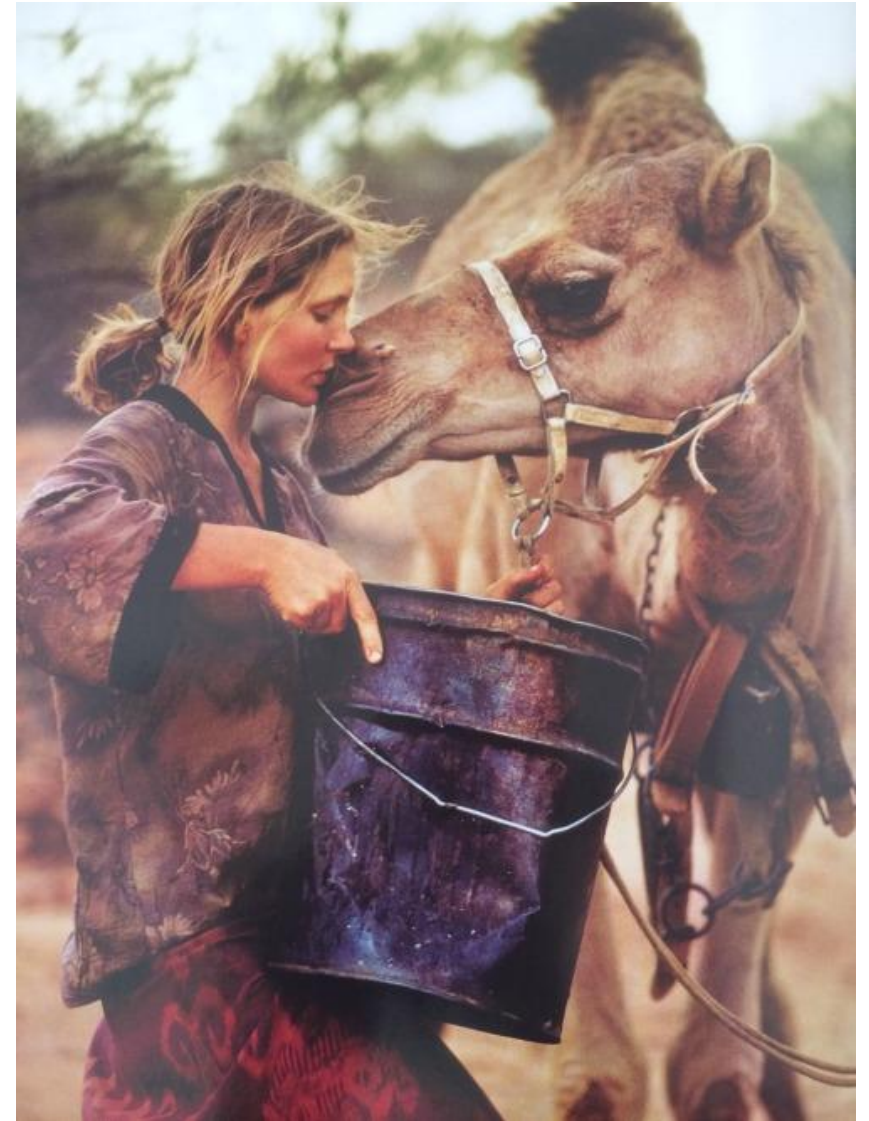
