## Trip to Strafford Olympic Park on Monday 15th November

**Trip Details:** As part of the A Level Geography course, your daughter has to complete an independent fieldwork investigation for their Non-Examined Assessment (NEA). This forms 20% of their overall grade. For our Year 13s to collect their primary data, we will be visiting Stratford and the Olympic Park to investigate their chosen field of enquiry. This trip will take place on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> November.

We are also opening this trip to our Year 12 Geographers so they can gain important fieldwork enquiry skills. They will be completing their own fieldwork investigation with Mrs Basirat with the focus on the new Changing Places compulsory unit.

Although this is an independent enquiry, students are allowed to collect their primary data as a group. Therefore, your daughter will benefit from attending this trip even if they have chosen to investigate an alternative area, as they will experience a full range of data collection techniques.

<u>**Travel:**</u> Your daughter will be informed of details closer to the time, but we will be leaving school after 9:30am and returning before 4:30pm.

<u>Cost:</u> We are applying for free train transport as a school group, but if this is not possible, your daughter will be required to use their Oyster card to pay for train and tube transport into Zone 1. Your daughter will also need to bring a packed lunch or money to purchase food.

<u>Requirements</u> Please sign and return the reply slip to me, replies must be received by **Monday 18**<sup>th</sup> **October** 

<u>Behaviour Expectations</u> Your daughter's place on this trip is subject to satisfactory behaviour, attendance and conduct within school and this will be constantly monitored before the trip. If your daughter's attendance or behaviour is deemed to be unsatisfactory, she will not be allowed to participate.

Whilst on the visit please emphasise to your daughter that she will be required to follow the instructions and advice of the Party Leader and other accompanying adults as well as demonstrating correct theatre etiquette at all times.
