



Dear Parent(s)/Carer,

Compulsory trip – Geography GCSE Stratford and Olympic Park

As part of the GCSE Geography course, your daughter has to complete 3 examinations. One of these examinations is based on Geographical applications and Geographical skills. This is where students will need to know and understand the skills involved in collecting geographical data and analysis of these data. In order to cover the requirements that the exam board has set us, we will be visiting Worthing Beach on the South coast and Stratford transport and Olympic Park to conduct a fieldwork investigation. The Stratford trip will take place on **Tuesday 28th June 2022**. This is a compulsory part of the course and your daughter needs to participate in order to achieve well in her examinations.

Your daughter will be informed of details closer to the time, but we will be leaving school by coach around 9:00am and arrival back at school around 4:45pm

Travel and trip details: The plan for the trip is as follows:

9:00am	-Students meet in school canteen and board the coaches
11:00am	-Students conduct data collection at 2 sites in Stratford
1:00pm	-Lunch and investigation of services within Westfield
1:45pm	-Data collection at 2 further sites in Stratford and the Olympic Park
3:15pm	-Leave Stratford and return to School by coach
4:45pm	-Return to school. Students dismissed

Cost: The cost of the trip is for the coaches only and will be **£14:50** per student. Due to restrictions with trips last year, we are planning both fieldwork trip within the same month and will open ParentPay early to enable you to budget and plan ahead for these trips.

Requirements: Your daughter will need to bring a packed lunch and she must be in full school uniform. If your daughter is in receipt of free school meals, please indicate on the reply slip so this can be arranged for her. Please log on to [Parentpay](#) to make the non refundable payment and give your consent. All replies must be received by **April 30th 2022**.

Your daughter's place on this trip is subject to satisfactory behaviour, attendance and conduct within school and this will be constantly monitored before the trip. If your daughter's attendance or behaviour is deemed to be unsatisfactory, she will not be allowed to participate. If she is not allowed on the trip, **there will be no refund of any monies paid**.

Whilst on the visit please emphasise to your daughter that she will be required to follow the instructions and advice of the Party Leader and other accompanying adults.
