Dear Parents/Guardians,

National Gallery- 22nd March 2022

We invite our Year 8 students to attend a trip to The National Gallery on the 22nd March 2022. The students will be able to have the enjoyment of listening to a gallery speaker who will cover the topic of myths and legends through visual language of paintings for the first hour at the gallery. This is a great opportunity for the students to be proactive and part of a conversation about art that is outside the school.

Places for this school trip are limited therefore the spaces are available on a first come first served basis. Students are not expected to go to their usual registration on this day but instead meet Mrs Fernandes at 8:30am in F2 where they will be registered.

We will aim to leave the school by 9am and arrive at the gallery just before 10:30am where they will meet their tour guide. After the guided tour, students will be given resources to use in groups as part of a self-guided tour. We will also give students the opportunity to visit the gallery gift shop towards the end of our visit. Students are welcome to bring pocket change if they wish to make small purchases at the shop. We will aim to leave the gallery by 2pm and arrive back to the school at 3pm.

The cost of both outbound and return journey is covered by Transport for London School Party Travel Scheme and will be free of charge to students.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch and drinks that they can carry with them on the during the day. Uniform expectations stand the same as any other day at school. Please advise your child to bring a lightweight waterproof coat in case of any rain.

To sign up to this trip please complete the online consent form and pay £1.00 to cover printing fees via Parent Pay via www.parentpay.com. Your place on the trip is only secure once you have paid. Please note that the trip will be taken off Parent Pay once all spaces are taken up.

Your daughter's place on this trip is subject to satisfactory behaviour, attendance and conduct within school and this will be constantly monitored before the trip. If your daughter's attendance or behaviour is deemed to be unsatisfactory, she will not be allowed to participate.

Whilst on the visit please emphasise to your daughter that she will be required to follow the instructions and advice of the Party Leader and other accompanying adults.
