### **Compulsory trip – Geography GCSE Worthing Beach**

As part of the GCSE Geography course, your daughter has to complete 3 examinations. One of these examinations is based on Geographical applications and Geographical skills. This is where students will need to know and understand the skills involved in collecting geographical data and analysis of these data. In order to cover the requirements that the exam board has set us, we will be visiting Worthing Beach on the South coast and Stratford transport and Olympic Park to conduct a fieldwork investigation. The Worthing trip will take place on **Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2022**. This is a compulsory part of the course and your daughter needs to participate in order to achieve well in her examinations.

Your daughter will be informed of details closer to the time, but we will be leaving school by coach around 9:00am.

#### **Travel and trip details:**

The plan for the trip is as follows:

9:00am	-Students meet in school canteen and board the coaches
11:00am	-Students conduct data collection
1:00pm	-Packed Lunch on Worthing Beach
1:30pm	-Students conduct data collection
2:00pm	-Leave Worthing and return to School by coach
3:30pm	-Return to school. Students dismissed

**Cost:** The cost of the trip is for the coaches only and will be **£13:50** per student. Due to restrictions with trips last year, we are planning both fieldwork trip within the same month and will open ParentPay early to enable you to budget and plan ahead for these trips.

**Requirements:** Your daughter will need to bring a packed lunch and she must be in full school uniform. If your daughter is in receipt of free school meals, please indicate on the reply slip so this can be arranged for her. Sensible footwear with good grip soles and/waterproof properties may be worn as we will be on the beach and shoreline for the day. We also recommend waterproof coats and sunscreen depending on the forecasted weather conditions. Staff will accompany students at all times. Please log on to [Parentpay](#) to make the payment and give your consent. All replies must be received by **April 30<sup>th</sup> 2022**.

Your daughter's place on this trip is subject to satisfactory behaviour, attendance and conduct within school and this will be constantly monitored before the trip. If your daughter's attendance or behaviour is deemed to be unsatisfactory, she will not be allowed to participate. If she is not allowed on the trip, **there will be no refund of any monies paid**.

Whilst on the visit please emphasise to your daughter that she will be required to follow the instructions and advice of the Party Leader and other accompanying adults.
