<b>Subject</b>	<b>Tasks/activities</b>
<b>Art</b>	Complete all the work set since March. Take minimum 40 good quality photographs.
<b>Biology</b>	Complete practise examination questions and create mind maps/flash cards/knowledge organisers for each unit of modules 1-4 studied in AS Biology
<b>Business Studies</b>	Research and complete a SWOT, PESTLE: Porters 5 Forces.
<b>Chemistry</b>	Multiple choice knowledge quizzes for each unit. Create knowledge organisers for each unit studied this year.
<b>Computer Science</b>	Start Planning your NEA Project - analysis
<b>Dance</b>	Unit 1 – Present conclusions and independent judgements through effective investigation: write a 1000 word (500 per practitioner) summary of your findings from your research.
<b>Drama</b>	A range of tasks across different exam components.
<b>English</b>	Read 'Frankenstein' and 2 books from companion text list. Complete journal.
<b>Film Studies</b>	Make sure all outstanding work is completed. Write plans for four Coursework short films. Optional extension – complete one of the online courses shared by Mr Nott.
<b>Geography</b>	Write NEA introduction including detailed location, rationale, wider research and theory.
<b>Government and Politics</b>	Read chapter on US constitution and complete theory exam question.
<b>History</b>	Do background reading for coursework and make a coursework plan.
<b>Law</b>	Complete the A level summer work booklet and read the chapter on the UK appeals system.
<b>Maths</b>	Prepare for end of Year exam to take place on Friday 7 <sup>th</sup> August, Exam will be posted on SMHW from 10am to 11:40am to allow enough time for downloading and getting started. Papers should be submitted to Mrs Foley by 11:55am on the same day by email or via show my homework by scanning in or taking photos of the work.
<b>Media Studies</b>	Make sure all outstanding work is completed. Write Statement of Aims for your coursework project. Optional extension – complete one of the online courses shared by Mr Nott.
<b>Psychology</b>	Complete collection of data – aiming for about 3 to 5 participants for each study.
<b>Physics</b>	Create knowledge organisers for each unit in Module 3 and module 4. Complete multiple-choice questions and past examination questions.
<b>Sociology</b>	Complete project on New Religious Movement.
