Measles, Chicken Pox and Shingles

One of our students in Year 8 is receiving medical treatment for an immune deficiency.

This puts the student at serious risk if exposed to measles, chicken pox or shingles.

If you suspect your daughter has measles, chicken pox or shingles please inform the school immediately, as the student will need to have an injection within 3 days of contact due to her reduced immune system.

It is also very important that you let us know if anyone in your household has shingles.

Your daughter is not at any risk from this situation. We are depending on the co-operation of all our students and parents/carers to help support this student to access education with risks to her minimised as far as possible.
