

GENERIC SCHOOL CONSENT FORM

SCHOOL VISITS AND OFF-SITE ACTIVITIES TO COVER ALL THE YEARS YOUR CHILD IS REGISTERED AT THE SCHOOL

- (a) To take part in school visits and other activities that take place off school premises; and
(b) To be given first aid or urgent medical treatment during any school visit or activity.

Please note the following important information before giving consent:

- The visits and activities covered by this consent includes:-
 - All visits which take place during term time, holidays or weekends
 - Adventure activities at any time
 - Off-site sporting fixtures outside the school day
 - Placements at venues related to specific courses
- The school will send you full details of each visit or activity before it takes place. For residential visits you will be asked to complete a separate insurance form.
- By informing the School in writing**, you can if you wish, withdraw your child from taking part in any particular school visit or activity.

Written parental consent will not be requested from you for the majority of off-site activities offered by the School e.g. year-group visits to local amenities – as such activities are part of the School's curriculum and usually take place during the normal school day.

Staff in charge will take all reasonable care of your child and you are consenting to explain to your child that s/he will be required to obey the instructions and advice of the Party Leader and other accompanying adults and will be subject to the School's general code of behaviour.

You are consenting to pay for any damage, which may be caused by the misconduct or carelessness of your child, to the person/property of any other party/parties.

You are asked to ensure that your child is in good health and is fit to go on any proposed visit. In the event of an accident or illness during a school visit or off-site activity, every effort will be made to contact you, but failing this medical treatment (including inoculations, surgery or blood transfusions) may be started which, in the opinion of a qualified medical practitioner, may be necessary for your child during the course of the visit or activity.

You are consenting to indemnify the Party Leader in respect of any expenses reasonably incurred in consequence of any accident to or illness to your child.

MEDICAL INFORMATION

Details of any medical condition that your child suffers from and any medication your child should take during off-site visits, should be communicated to the party leader prior to the visit if the information is not already available to the school on your child's records.
